Ensuring long-lasting WASH projects is a real challenge. The **Rotary Club of Vail** used \$85,000 to work with <u>COVA</u> to implement a program to provide training, capacity-building workshops, technical assistance, and water quality monitoring to 50 communities in Nicaragua. According to their <u>Impact Report</u>, after 24 months of regular visits, the communities are self-sufficient.
