Cannoli Recipe

(Served at February 2025 Lodge meeting)

An important part of the recipe is draining the ricotta cheese:

1. Place the ricotta cheese into a fine mesh strainer lined with cheesecloth, Place the strainer over a bowl. Place it covered, in the fridge to drain for at least 6 hours and up to 24 hours.

Ingredients for 12 cannoli:

30.5 oz. drained container of whole milk ricotta cheese

1 – 1.5 cups of confectioner sugar

2-3 tsp vanilla extract

Large dash of cinnamon, or to taste

About 1-1.5 cups mini semi-sweet chocolate chips, divided.

If more sugar is needed, add to taste.



2. Mix drained ricotta, confectioner sugar, vanilla extract, cinnamon, and about 1 cup chocolate chips. We let it sit for several hours to meld the flavors.

3. Fill the shells using a spoon or pastry bag with a tip. Dip the ends of the cannoli with chocolate chips and dust with confectioner sugar.

Fill the shells shortly before serving. The cream keeps for several days.

Shells can be easily purchased at World Market in Vacaville. The package contains 12 medium shells. \$5.99 for 12 shells.
