VILLAGE WATER PROJECT COMMUNITY ASSESSMENT

There are couple of identified communities with no good source of water to drink or use for household activities. These communities have to travel far to get water from shallow streams around to use for cooking and drinking without the water being subjected to any treatment. Rotary Club of Abeokuta intend to dig a borehole in 3 of these communities to meet their water scarcity challenges and the communities that surrounds them.

Village 1 (Otooto) is located in Owode Obafemi local government area of Abeokuta. Population is about 600 people with additional 1500 people from adjoining 4 communities which will all benefit from the project.

Village 2 (Ile Olu) in Odeda local government area of Abeokuta. The population of this village is about 350 people and an additional 600 people in the surrounding villages.

Village 3 (Akinale) in Ewekoro local government. This is a village that Rotary club of Abeokuta had adopted as project center for many years. Population in this village is over 500, with more people in the adjoining villages.
